Background

In June 2023, the inhabitants of the Canton of Geneva enshrined the right to food in its Constitution. This decision stems from:

- → Increasing food precariousness
- → Declining human and planetary health
- → A peasantry in crisis

A cantonal draft bill is under way and, in the meantime, several civil society organisations have launched a pilot project: Calim.

From the pitchfork to the fork

Food and agriculture are closely intertwined: you cannot conceive of one without the other. Calim rebuilds the local connection around food and food production, ensuring access to healthy foods of our choice and bringing value back into the local agriculture.

A Geneva testing ground

The Caisse genevoise de l'alimentation works along the principle of food democracy. Since 2024, two groups of neighbours (Meyrin & Pâquis) meet regularly. Jointly, they decide on the governance and functioning of Calim, as well as the places where its members can spend their monthly allowance.
